Please bring small, bright pieces of fabric for the prairie points, bright color thread or Blenable thread for the quilting, trims, cording, ribbon, and beads. Please bring your sewing machines and there will be extra ones for those that do not receive this information.



The Snap Happy Purse Pattern has instructions for 3 small bag sizes. Finished sizes are 7 1/2" x 6", 6" x 5", and 5" x 4 1/2".

Materials Needed: Makes 3 small bags

- Two fat quarters of coordinating fabrics *
- Several three to four inch squares of coordinating fabric for Prairie point tabs for each bag
- A 3/4" metal carpenter measuring tape *
- 1/2 yd of fusible Pellon light weight batting *
- 1/4 yd of light weight interfacing *
- Masking tape or duct tape *
